2. Jared Stewart, the Economic Development Director introduced the Community Development Block Grant and explained the purpose of the meeting, to give the public a chance to provide input and to make sure we meet the requirements of the community development block grant.

Mr. Stewart then explained the Community Development Block Grant is federally operated program, managed for Tooele City through the Wasatch Front Regional Council with the purpose of making community improvements specifically for low to moderate income neighborhoods, individuals, and families.

The two projects that have been proposed for our community this year are one, the Boys and Girls Club to assist in the construction and remodel of their building which will benefit the community and low- and moderate-income families.

Second project, sewer improvement project in the in Broadway Neighborhood area. We are hopeful that this year, with fewer applicants, that we should get funding for both projects.

The Chairman then opened the public hearing and invited anyone from the public to speak. There were no public comments.

Chairman Brady made a motion to approve the Community Development Block Grant applications as stated by Mr. Stewart.
