# 3. Recommendation on Providence at Overlake Subdivision Phase 1 and 2 Preliminary Plan, a 7.85 acre 26 lot single family residential subdivision located at approximately 1400 North 400 West.

Presented by Rachelle Custer

This application is a request for approval of a preliminary plan for approximately 7.85 acres located at approximately 400 West 1200 North. The property is currently zoned R 1-7 Residential. The applicant is requesting that a preliminary plan be approved to allow for 26 single family residential lots. Lots range in size from 7,000 square feet to 9,000 square feet as allowed in this zoning district. This is the preliminary plan for phases 1 and 2; the City will receive the final plat for phase 1 shortly. The final plat for phase 2 will be received when phase 1 sells out.

Chairman Robinson asked the Commission if they had any questions or concerns.

Commissioner Sloan asked if the large lot in the northwest corner was an area for water retention; Ms. Custer verified that is a water retention basin.

Commissioner Montano asked how large the lots would be; Ms. Custer replied that they will be 7,000 to 9,000 square feet.

Commissioner Hammer asked when double-frontage lots will be discussed. Ms. Custer responded that double-frontage lots will be discussed when they approve the final plat. She stated that phase 1 will not have double-frontage lots, but that phase 2 will have double-frontage lots.

Chairman Robinson asked if there were any more questions from the Commission; there weren't any.

Commissioner Sloan moved to forward a positive recommendation to the City Council for the Providence at Overlake Subdivision Phases 1 & 2 Preliminary Plan, for the purpose of creating 26 single family residential lots at approximately 400 W 1200 N, application number P17-669, based on the findings and subject to the conditions listed in the Staff Report dated March 14, 2018.

Commissioner Bevan seconded the motion. The vote was as follows: Commissioner Hammer, "Aye," Commissioner Graf, "Aye," Commissioner Sloan, "Aye," Commissioner Bevan, "Aye," Commissioner Clark, "Aye," Commissioner Montano, "Aye," Chairman Robinson, "Aye." The motion passed.
