

CHAPTER 4. ELECTRICAL CODE

4-4-1. National Electric Code.

Tooele City recognizes that the State of Utah has adopted the National Electric Code, as amended and/or revised, as law governing the State of Utah and all political subdivisions thereof. To the extent that Tooele City is not preempted by the law of the State of Utah from adopting the National Electric Code as an ordinance of Tooele City, its most current edition is so adopted. 4-4-2. Penalties.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of the National Electrical Code shall be deemed guilty of a class C misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine under Section 76-3-301, Utah Code Annotated, or by imprisonment in the Tooele County jail for a period not exceeding 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment."
