You can access the Business license Application on the city's web site at www.tooelecity.org; go to the "Department Drop Down List" to City Recorder. You will see a list of applications to the left of the screen. The Business license Application is the first one. Fill out the application (2nd page needs to be notarized). After being approved you will be contacted regarding payment of the \$40 fee. After payment, your Business License Certificate will be mailed to you.
