Thanks to all who came to the event and donated to our local food bank!





2011 Fridays on Vine



City ordinance prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 2 am to 6 am during the winter months. Please help city snowplow drivers by not parking on the streets and keeping things like basketball hoops off the streets!



Keep your driveway and walks clear so that firefighters, medics and postal workers can reach your house or business.

Ensure all private roads are kept clear so fire apparatus and ambulances can reach your home. Remove all snow and ice adjacent to emergency exits, especially those exits that are infrequently used. Keep snow and ice cleared from outside stairs.

If a major storm occurs, the fire hydrants nearest your home should be kept clear so that firefighters can readily locate and use it.

Ensure your pets are kept safe and secure when outside temperatures are below freezing.

BUSINESS LICENSE REQUIRED!

ANYONE OFFERING A "SERVICE" FROM THEIR HOME, FOR COMPENSATION, REQUIRES A TOOELE CITY BUSINESS LICENSE. This includes Contractors even though they may be licensed by the State. You can access our Business License Application on our website at www.tooelecitey.org; go to the "Department Drop Down List" to City Recorder; you will see a list of applications to the left of the screen; the Business License Application is the first one. Fill out the application; the 2nd page does need to be notarized (we have notaries at City Hall); it takes a few days to go through the approval process; after being approved we will contact you regarding payment of the \$40 fee; after payment, your Business License Certificate will be mailed to you. If you have any other questions you may call the Recorder's Office at (435) 843-2110. Thank you for your cooperation!!

Door-to-Door Salesman

ALL door-to-door salesmen (Itinerant/Transient Merchants) must be licensed with Tooele City and must have a NEW **BLUE (for 2012) Tooele City ID Badge** on and in plain sight. If they aren't wearing a badge and it is during the day, you can call the Recorder's Office at (435) 843-2110. If it is the weekend or evening, you can contact Dispatch (435) 882-5600 and they will have a police officer in your area. Thank you for your help!!

ATTENTION BUSINESS OWNERS:

Those who have not paid their Business License Renewal fee: A 50% LATE FEE will be implemented on February 1, 2012. You will have until March 1, 2012, to pay the licensing fee + the penalty fee. If we have not heard from you, your license will be considered "inactive" and we will CLOSE your business after March 15, 2012. You can mail in your payment, drop your payment off in the Finance Department at City Hall OR put it in the drop box to the south of City Hall. We are not able to do online bill pay this year as we implemented a new licensing program VERY RECENTLY and the system is not set up as of yet to do so. We apologize for this inconvenience. Strengthen a family. Become a foster parent.

The Utah Foster Care Foundation believes every child deserves a permanent connection to a caring adult. The need for foster/adoptive families is ongoing, especially for families willing to help keep siblings together and to care for children over age 6. Right now, there are nearly **1,400 children and teens** in foster care in the Tooele/SLC Region.

Families initially receive 32 hours of free training, ongoing training and encouragement of foster parent support groups in their area, and the knowledge that they are helping local children in need.

Do you wonder what it is like to be a foster parent? We will be having an **Ask-a-Foster Parent Night** on **Thursday February 2nd** at the **Tooele City Library** from **6:30-7:30 pm**. This will be a great time to learn more about the needs of children in foster care from a local foster parent and to see how you can help.


