Thank you for your support of Fridays on Vine this year! It was a fun and exciting year, full of great performances. There were some new groups this season, such as the high-energy song and dance group *Synergy*, singer/song writer *Ellee Duke*, and the fun *Rockin' Rob and the Hound Dogs*. We also brought back some old favorites such as *Kerry Christensen*, *Lokal-grown*, *T3* and *Charley Jenkins* – just to name a few.

This year we had a chalk art contest in conjunction with one of the concerts and gave away some cool prizes. We wrapped up the season by partnering with the Tooele County Chamber of Commerce where everyone was able to purchase a meal for only \$1.00 (or a can of food) and then we took a walk down memory lane as the group *Imagine* performed our favorite Beatles' songs.

The Tooele City Arts Council organized Fridays on Vine, but it is made possible through the PAR (Parks, Arts and Recreation) program. The PAR program also provides art classes and workshops, children's theater, park improvements, and grants to community art organizations such as LaForge Encore Theatre and the Tooele Arts Festival.

The PAR program is funded with a 1/10 of 1% tax that the voters approved in 2004. To break that down, 1/10 of 1% is only 1 cent for every \$10.00! You have the

opportunity to renew the PAR program this November which will allow these types of concerts to continue. Watch for this language on the ballot this November: Tooele City Proposal #1: "Shall Tooele City, Utah, reauthorize a 1/10th of 1% sales and use tax to fund cultural facilities, cultural organizations, and recreational facilities in Tooele City?"
