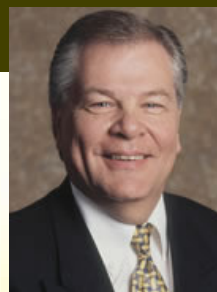
On Monday, July 15th, we cut the ribbon on the new solids handling facility at the

Tooele City Water Reclamation Facility. The completion of our new solids handling facility means we are now able to reuse 99% of the water and solid waste coming into the plant. Both the reuse water and the solids material, that can be use as fertilizer, will become a very valuable resource for the city, generating revenue and saving the city money. I'm very proud of the project we've completed there. Our solids facility is the only one of its kind in the United States. It took a great deal of courage to choose this process, but it has exceeded our expectations many times over.

We will be doing some significant road maintenance projects in the coming weeks. The largest will involve Utah Avenue from Main Street west to the railroad crossing on SR112. It involves new water service lines as well as a

complete overlay of the road surface. Please bear with us, there will be detours and some delays on a project of this size. The good thing is it shouldn't take too long to complete.

Public service is a very special privilege to me. I take it very seriously. The work we do and the projects we complete make our City better. Our focus will always be to enhance your quality of life here in Tooele City. We manage our finances and conduct our business professionally and courteously. **Outdoor watering is not permitted on Sundays.**

The City encourages residents not to water during the hottest hours of the day, between 10 am and 6 pm. If there are special circumstances that require a modified schedule for residents or businesses—such as newly planted sod or lawn, contact Tooele City at 843-2150.

City parks and schools have been placed on a modified schedule because of the size of their lawn areas.

**Utah Avenue Waterline Repair and Roadwork...a message from Tooele City**

The Utah Avenue waterline service and roadway improvement project is under way, and will cause temporary closures and restrictions between SR-36 and 1100 West over the coming several weeks. This closure is necessary in order to facilitate construction and to shorten the duration of the project, as well as to provide safe conditions for the construction workers and the public. The first phase of the project involves waterline repairs to the aging water system, as well as the replacement of old fire hydrants and the addition of several new fire hydrants which will provide additional protection for the homes and businesses in the area. This initial phase of the work is anticipated to last until the mid part of August.

Upon completion of the underground utilities, the second phase of the project will commence. The second phase will involve edge milling and overlay paving of the entire roadway. All work is anticipated to be complete by the first part of September. Funding for the entire roadway portion of this work is from a state grant, and is not being paid for using general fund dollars or the City's other roadway preservation funds.

We apologize for the temporary inconvenience of the travel restrictions, and ask for your continued patience as we work to complete this important water service and transportation project in a timely and cost effective manner.

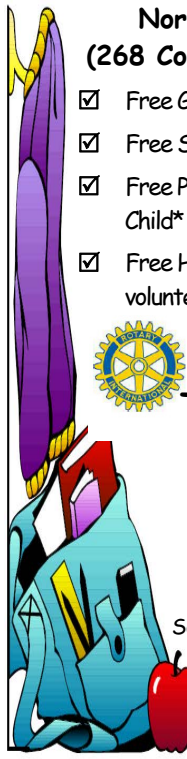

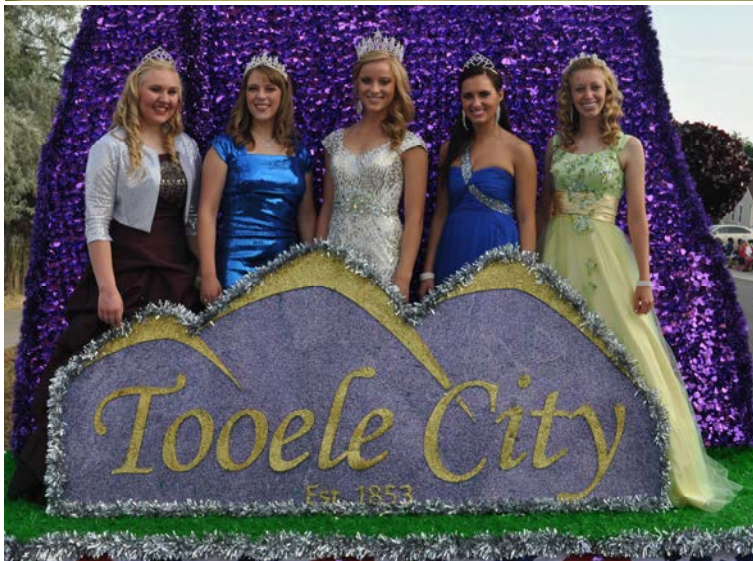

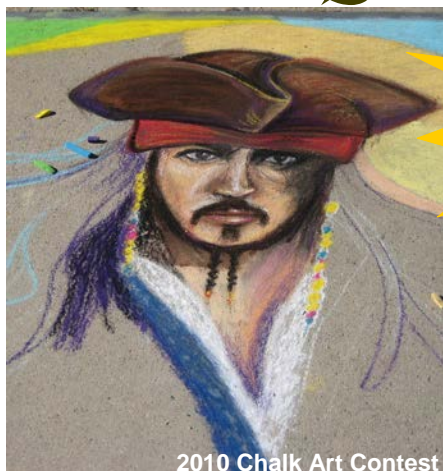
