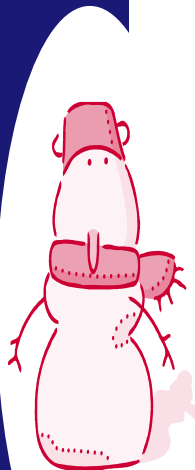

2011 Fridays on Vine

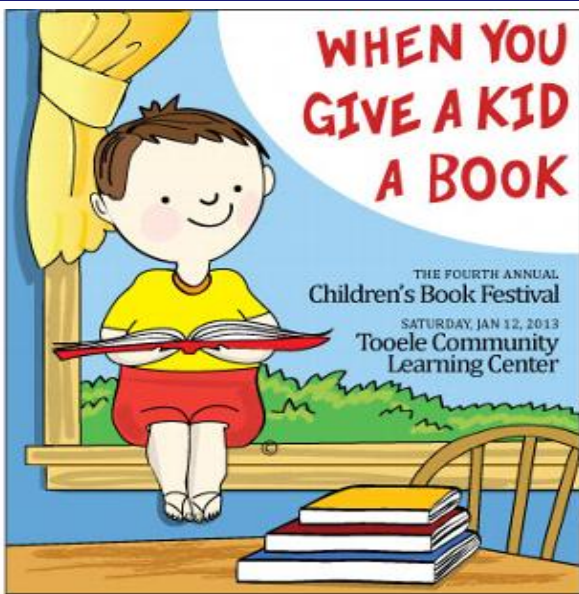

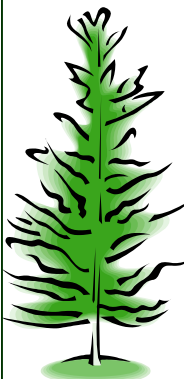

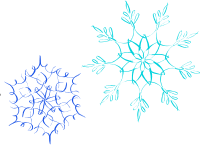
