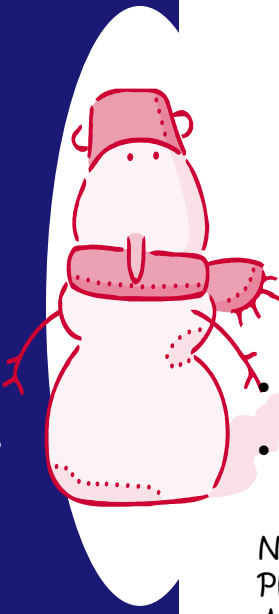

Residents are encouraged to dispose of their Christmas trees by placing them at the curbside on their bulky waste pick-up day. In addition to Christmas trees, other acceptable items include: old appliances, furniture, carpet, couches and mattresses. All smaller items must be bagged, boxed or bundled. Bundles must be less than 5 ft. long, under 18" in diameter and less than 75 lbs., tied with twine.

Keep Your Pipes Open to Avoid Freezing

Every year when the weather turns cold, the City receives a rash of reports of frozen pipes. The best thing that you can do to prevent this in your home is to keep the pipes open. Leaving a slow drip or trickle in a faucet overnight, when the temperature and water usage is lowest, can prevent the water in your pipes from sitting still and freezing. As the weather gets colder over a longer stretch of time, the ground freezes deeper and deeper and puts more homes at risk for frozen pipes. Yes, the slow drip or trickle may end up costing you a little extra on your water bill, but that amount will be dramatically less than the cost to repair frozen pipes and the water damage it can cause in your home.

ATTENTION BUSINESS OWNERS:

For those who have not paid their Business License Renewal fee: A 50% LATE FEE will be implemented on February 1, 2014. You will have until March 1, 2014 to pay the licensing fee + the penalty fee. If we have not heard from you, your license will be considered "inactive" and we will CLOSE your business after March 15, 2014. You can mail in your payment, drop your payment off in the Finance Department at City Hall OR in the drop box to the south of City Hall. If you are no longer in business, please let us know in writing, by e-mailing lisac@tooelecity.org and we will close your license. If you have questions, please contact the Recorder's Office at (435) 843-2110.

Anyone Offering a "Service" from their home, for compensation, requires a Tooele City Business License. Call the Tooele City Recorder's Office (435) 843-2110 for more information. Also, ALL door-to-door salesmen (Itinerant/Transient Merchants) must be licensed with Tooele City and must have a 2014 YELLOW Tooele City ID Badge on and in plain sight. If salesmen aren't wearing a badge call (435) 843-2110 or Dispatch at (435) 882-5600.

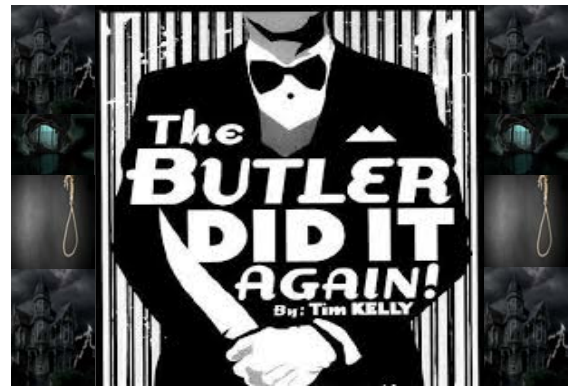
