## Message from Mayor Dunlavy...

I know there is a great deal of interest in the Utah Department of Transportation's (UDOT) rebuild project on Tooele City's Main Street. I want to remind those of you who don't already know, Tooele's Main Street is a state highway; that is the reason they are doing the rebuild project. I'm very grateful funding was earmarked to do the project, as it has been badly needed for many years. I'm excited for the project to be completed. I know there will be some challenges, but UDOT has been exceptional to work with on the planning and timing for completion. I encourage all of you to take some time and make yourself aware of the alternate routes around construction, as well as the alternate

accesses to the businesses on Main Street. I have been very appreciative with the attention UDOT has given to the businesses and the residents on Main Street who will be affected. With a little planning and patience by everyone, I'm confident we'll be very pleased with the project when it's done.

I want you all to know, because of the construction project, the 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade route this year will be changed slightly. The parade will move along the normal route until it gets to Utah Avenue, at that point the parade (instead of continuing north to 400 North as has been the normal route) will turn west on Utah Avenue to 200 West and then south to the city park on Vine and 200 West. As has become a tradition, there will be exciting 4<sup>th</sup> of July events the whole week leading up to the 4<sup>th</sup>, more information will be coming soon. ## SR-36 RENEWED

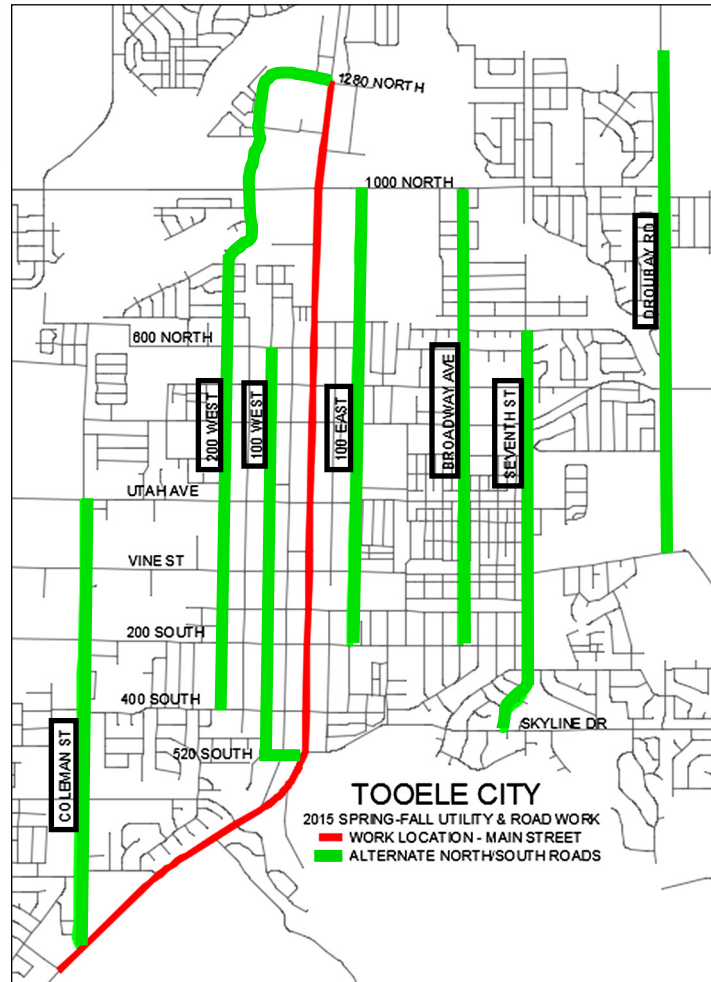
3 O'Clock Drive to Stansbury

Construction began in late March to replace the waterline main in Main Street between Old Canyon Road (approx. 650 South) and 600 North. This project is scheduled to be completed before June 1st, at which time UDOT will begin road construction. During construction, the intent is to keep one lane of traffic open in each direction through construction areas, but we are asking citizens to be patient and to plan ahead. Please use alternative routes when possible. We have highlighted several roads that could be possible North-South alternate routes.

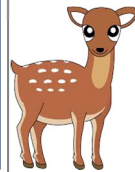

Deer are a part of the wild life of Utah and Tooele City is in their natural habitat. While we are coexisting with deer, here are a few facts to keep in mind:

- Tooele City will not shoot them, trap them or try to control them
- Discharging a firearm within the City limits is illegal
- Killing a deer without a license or out of season is illegal
- Deer do not obey traffic laws, so watch out for them on the roadways!

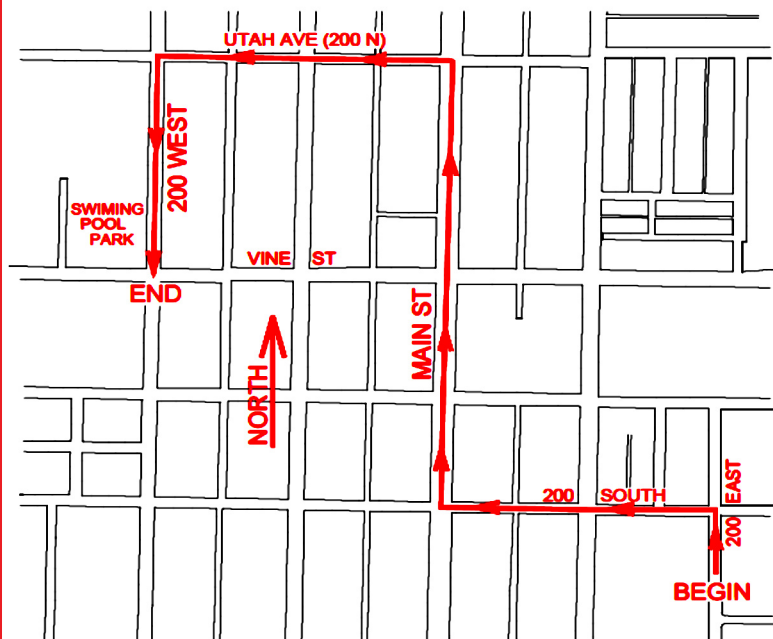
