# Water Conservation Schedule

Area #1 All water users north of Vine and west of Main water Wednesdays and Saturdays.

Area #2 All water users north of Vine and east of Main water Tuesdays and Fridays.

Area #3 All water users south of Vine water Mondays and Thursdays.

### Outdoor watering is not permitted on Sundays.

The City encourages residents not to water during the hottest hours of the day, between 10 am and 6 pm. If there are special circumstances that require a modified schedule for residents or businesses—such as newly planted sod or lawn, contact Tooele City at 843-2150.

City parks and schools have been placed on a modified schedule because of the size of their lawn areas.

Thank you for your help in conserving water—a precious resource!



### Construction Update:

Construction on SR-36 is well underway from 520 [ South to 1280 North.

Paving operations are beginning in the north section, on the east side of the road, and progressing south. Two lanes in each direction from 700 North to 1000 North will be restored by mid-August. The remaining areas will have one lane in each direction until the reconstruction is complete, which is anticipated to be by the end of 2015. We are encouraging drivers to use alternate routes. We anticipate this will add additional traffic to local roads. Please be patient when using these alternate routes and observe the posted speed limit.

### School is Back in Session:

Our team has been working closely with the Tooele County School District throughout the project. The new school year begins August 25, 2015. The start of school means we'll see lots of children using local roads to walk or ride to school. Drivers, please pay extra attention while driving during school hours and be aware of pedestrian and bicycle traffic. Our team and the Tooele School District are also working closely with local law enforcement officials to start the school year safely.

In addition, we ask all parents to take a few minutes to talk to their children about safety. Remind them of the importance of using sidewalks and crosswalks, as well as looking both ways before crossing any street. This would also be a good time to remind them of their safe route to school and the importance of following it, without any side trips, each and every day.

Safety is the top priority for our crews and the Tooele County School District. We ask that everyone in the community make this their top priority as well. Together we can all make this a safe and happy school year.


