FROM THE MAYOR...

We are continuing to work on some exciting projects this coming year, including our retail development and assisting the Utah Department of Transportation with the complete rebuild of Main

Street (SR-36).

I wanted to update you on the developments-to-date on the State's relocation of the Utah State Prison. We are continuing to oppose the Miller property in the middle of our valley, as well as any other site in the Tooele Valley. I firmly believe there is no positive effect of having a prison here.

The City Council and I, in conjunction with Mayor Marshall and the Grantsville City Council, will adamantly oppose any site in our valley. We continue to work closely with the Miller family in

asking them to remove their property as a potential site.

I would encourage you to go to the Tooele City website and read the resolution the City Council adopted. It is our detailed opinion and the facts concerning the Miller site.

In order to meet publishing and mailing deadlines, these articles are written and submitted before the first of the month. My hope is when you read this, the Miller site and other Tooele valley sites are no longer being considered. In the event they are, we will continue to oppose them.



The Utah Department of Transportation will be in attendance at the **Tooele City Council meeting on March 4, 2015 at 7:00 p.m.** to give a kick-off presentation for the Main Street reconstruction project. The project is set to begin construction in late spring or early summer 2015. There will be a public open house immediately following the Council meeting. Please plan on attending to meet the design team and see what the plans are for this significant project that will considerably improve Tooele's main thoroughfare.

Security Tips from the Tooele City Police Department



Due to ongoing vehicle burglary and vehicle theft trends, the Tooele City Police Department would like to remind you of some very important security tips:

Remember to keep your personal belongings and valuables out of view in your vehicles. It is also important to keep vehicle windows closed and doors locked. Often, stolen items are left in plain sight within the vehicle making them a prime target for thieves. There have been several reports of unlocked vehicles being targeted, rummaged through and items stolen. Some of the items have been used later to commit other crimes, such as Identity Theft and Fraud.

Recently, the Police Department has seen an increase in vehicle thefts. Commonly the vehicles that have been stolen have been left to idle in a driveway or garage. Remember, never leave your car running and unattended, even to warm it up in the morning. Never leave your keys in the car and always park in a well-lighted area, when possible.

Finally, don't hesitate to report suspicious activity. If you see a suspicious person who appears to be looking in vehicles, or loitering in a neighborhood or parking lot for no legitimate reason, call 435-882-5600.



It is now Animal License Renewal time for 2015. Please renew your license by February 28th or your license fee will double as of March 1st.

All dogs and cats within Tooele City limits and over the age of four months must be licensed each year. The license renewal application must be accompanied by a current rabies vaccination certificate. Female/Male Dog - \$20.00

Neutered or spayed dog - \$10.00 (Must indicate on Rabies Certificate animal is neutered or spayed or have supporting documentation.)


Female/Male Cat - 10.00
