

We hope that you, your families and friends have a Happy and SAFE Halloween.

Here are some safety tips for children and adults:

1. Avoid trick-or-treating alone. Walk in groups or with a trusted adult.
2. Add reflective tape to costumes and bags.
3. Choose face paint and makeup whenever possible, instead of masks which can obstruct vision.
4. Make sure swords, canes, or sticks are short and not sharp.
5. Prepare flashlights with fresh batteries for children and escorts.
6. Examine all treats for choking hazards and signs of tampering. Avoid eating home-made treats made by strangers.
7. Walk on sidewalks whenever possible, or on the far edge of the road facing traffic.
8. Only visit homes with a porch light on and never enter a home or car for a treat.
9. Teach children to call 911 if they have an emergency or become lost.
10. If your older children are going alone, plan and review the route that is acceptable to you. Agree on a specific time when they should return home.

## SR-36 RENEWED

3 O'Clock Drive to Stansbury

The SR-36 (Main Street) Renewed project is well underway from 3 O'Clock Drive to Stansbury Parkway. Crews began construction in early June and have made substantial progress so far. Crews will continue to head south with paving operations through October and November. We anticipate that new sections will be paved approximately every three weeks. Once pavement on the east side has been placed, traffic will be moved to the new pavement and the west side of the road will be reconstructed. The project is currently on schedule for completion at the end of 2015.

Our team thanks the local community for your continued support and patience with us as we complete this project. Please remember to use alternate routes to avoid delays within the construction zone and to use side and back street entrances to access local businesses. When traveling on these local roads, please observe the posted speed limit and stay alert at all times.

We also encourage everyone to sign-up to receive our weekly construction updates. The updates contain information on upcoming closures, traffic restrictions and work activities.
