I know there are some concerns about the large amounts of snow we got this winter. While I am very grateful for it, as it relates to our water resources, I have heard from some of you who are worried about the potential of flooding as the high mountain snow begins to melt.

We started monitoring the drainages coming from both Settlement Canyon and Middle Canyon early in the season. We inspected the drainage ditches to see if there were any problem areas that may create issues if

we get any runoff or the irrigation dam spills. While the drainage ditches are the responsibility of Tooele County and Settlement Canyon Irrigation Company, we wanted to be prepared for any developments.

In any event, I want you to know we are prepared to address any issues within the Tooele City limits. We've had an unusual spring, but the warm sunny days of summer are here. Let's all get outside and enjoy them!

NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL ELECTION & FILING PERIOD

to be voted on in the Tooele City Municipal General Election 1 Mayor and 2 City Council Members, 4 year terms each

To qualify for office, you must be: (1) a United States citizen; (2) at least 18 years old; (3) a resident of Tooele City for at least one year immediately preceding the date of the election; and (4) a registered voter. If there are a sufficient number of candidates, Tooele City will hold a primary election on August 15th. The general election

will be held November 7, 2017. If you are interested in running for office, visit the Tooele City Recorder's Office at 90 N. Main St., Tooele, or call (435) 843-2110.

The filing period runs from June 1, 2017 to June 7, 2017 during regular business hours (Monday - Friday, 8 am to 5 pm).

Water Conservation Schedule

Area #1 All water users north of Vine and west of Main water Wednesdays and Saturdays.

Area #2 All water users north of Vine and east of Main water Tuesdays and Fridays.

Area #3 All water users south of Vine water Mondays and Thursdays.

Outdoor watering is not permitted on Sundays.

The City encourages residents not to water during the hottest hours of the day, typically between 10 am and 6 pm. This conserves water and reduces your water bills.

If there are special circumstances that require a modified schedule for residents or businesses—such as newly planted sod or lawn, contact Tooele City at 843-2150.

City parks and schools have been placed on a modified schedule because of the size of their lawn areas. While some parks and schools may be watering more than two days each week, each specific area of that park is only watered twice during the week.

Per Tooele City Code Section 8-4-4 1(a), any weeds/grass on real property under 5 acres must be cut and maintained to under 6 inches in height. The property owner is responsible for the park strip area(s) adjacent to their lot(s). Any lot larger than

5 acres must have a 15 foot break of weeds cut and maintained under 6 inches, from adjacent lots inward.
