Area #1 All water users North of Vine and West of Main water Wednesdays and Saturdays.

Area #2 All water users North of Vine and East of Main water Tuesdays and Fridays.

Area #3 All water users South of Vine water Mondays and Thursdays.

Outdoor watering is not permitted on Sundays.

The City encourages residents not to water during the hottest hours of the day, typically between 10 am and 6 pm. This conserves water and reduces your water bills.

If there are special circumstances that require a modified schedule for residents or businesses-such as newly planted sod or lawn, contact Tooele City at (435) 843-2150.

City parks and schools have been placed on a modified schedule because of the size of their lawn areas. While some parks and schools may be watering more than two days each week, a specific area of that park is only watered twice during the week.

Tooele City is pleased to announce that beginning May 1, 2017, residents may sign up for the Curbside Recycling Program at any time. Once service begins, residents will only be allowed to opt-out of the program on an annual basis.

The cost of this service is \$5.65 per month per recycling receptacle.

When opted-in, residents will be delivered a blue recycling receptacle which will allow for plastics, metal, paper products and cardboard to be recycled. These items will need to be empty but will not have to be rinsed, cleaned or sorted prior to placing them in the recycling receptacle. Green waste and glass will not be recycled.

Opt-in forms may be found on our website, www.tooelecity.org, or in the Finance Office at City Hall (90 North Main Street, Tooele). A pickup schedule and a list of acceptable and non-acceptable recycling items will be delivered with your receptacle, and are also available on our website.



NUISANCE WEEDS:

Per Tooele City Code Section 8-4-4 1(a), any weeds/grass on real property under 5 acres must be cut and maintained to under 6 inches in height. The property owner is responsible for the park strip area(s) adjacent to their lot(s). Any lot larger than 5 acres must have a 15 foot break of

weeds cut and maintained under 6 inches, from adjacent lots inward.

DRINKING WATER SOURCE PROTECTION

The Tooele City Water Quality Report is available for your review, and has been mailed to all water utility account holders within the City. The Report is also available on the City's web page at the following link:

We are pleased to inform you that your drinking water continues to meet all U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and State drinking water health standards.

Tooele City vigilantly safeguards its water supplies by:

- · Establishing drinking water source protection zones for each of the City's sources.
- · Adoption of City Ordinance and reliance of County Ordinance which regulate potential hazards to the City's drinking water sources, and
- Collecting and analyzing water quality data to evaluate watershed protection efforts.

You can help by:

- Read and follow usage guidelines on detergents, fertilizers and pesticides,
- · Do your part to prevent runoff into the storm drain system,
- Properly dispose of household products such as cleaners, oil or gasoline and unused medicines,
- Continue your water conservation efforts, and;
- When you notice someone else contaminating the water, remind them that "We all live downstream."


INOPERABLE/UNLICENSED/ABANDONED VEHICLES:

Tooele City Code Section 8-4-4 1(c) and (d) states that junked, wrecked, unlicensed or inoperable vehicles may not be kept upon real property for longer than 72 hours. Only two inoperable/unlicensed motor vehicles may be kept upon real property if they are placed behind a screened fence, or in an enclosed building. Vehicle coverings are not considered in compliance with this code.
