Security Tips from the Tooele City Police Department



Due to ongoing vehicle burglary and vehicle theft trends, the Tooele City Police Department would like to remind you of some very important security tips:

Remember to keep your personal belongings and valuables out of view in your vehicles. It is also important to keep vehicle windows closed and doors locked. Often, stolen items are left in plain sight within the vehicle making them a prime target for thieves. There have been several reports of unlocked vehicles being targeted, rummaged through and items stolen. Some of the items have been used later to commit other crimes, such as Identity Theft and Fraud.

Commonly vehicles that are stolen have been left to idle in a driveway or garage. Remember, never leave your car running and unattended, even to warm it up in the morning. Never leave your keys in the car and always park in a well-lit area, when possible.

Finally, don't hesitate to report suspicious activity. If you see a suspicious person who appears to be looking in vehicles, or loitering in a neighborhood or parking lot for no legitimate reason, call dispatch at 435-882-5600.

Winter Reminders

City ordinance prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 2 a.m. to 6 a.m. from November to March.

Keep your driveway and walks clear so that firefighters, medics and postal workers can reach your house or business.

When major storms occur, the fire hydrants nearest to your home should be kept clear so that firefighters can readily locate and use them.

ATTENTION BUSINESS OWNERS:

Those who have not paid their Business License Renewal Fee: A 50% LATE FEE will be implemented on February 1, 2018. You will have until March 1, 2018 to pay the licensing fee + the penalty fee. If we have not heard from you, your license will be considered inactive and we will CLOSE your business after March 15, 2018. You can mail in your payment, you can drop your payment off in the Finance Department OR in the drop box to the South of City Hall. If you are no longer in business, please let us know in writing by e-mailing lisac@tooelecit.org and we will close your license. Animal Licenses

It is now Animal License Renewal time for 2018. Please renew your license by February 28th or your license fee will double as of March 1st.

All dogs and cats within Tooele City limits and over the age of four months must be licensed each year. The license renewal application must be accompanied by a current rabies vaccination certificate. License renewal fees may be paid at Tooele City Hall (90 North Main Street, Tooele) in the Finance Department. If you have any questions, please contact the Finance Department at (435) 843-2150.

Renewal Fees:

Female/Male Dog - \$20.00

Neutered or spayed dog - \$10.00

(Must indicate on Rabies Certificate animal is neutered or spayed or have supporting documentation.)

Female/Male Cat - 10.00

Spayed or Neutered Cat - \$5.00

(Must indicate on Rabies Certificate animal is neutered or spayed or have supporting documentation.)

Anyone offering a SERVICE from their home, for compensation, requires a Tooele City Business License. Call the Tooele City Recorder's Office (435) 843-2110 for more information. ALL door-to-door salespersons (Itinerant/Transient Merchants) must be licensed with Tooele City and must have a 2018 BLUE Tooele City ID Badge on and in plain sight. If salespersons aren't wearing badges, please call (435) 843-2110 or Dispatch (after 5 p.m. and on weekends) at (435) 882-5600. Please be sure to give Dispatch a complete description of the individual and the direction they are headed.
