The Tooele City Curbside Recycling Program began in February 2017. This service is available for residential customers who have a utility account with Tooele City. You may opt-in to this service at any time. A list of acceptable and non-acceptable recycling items is available online at tooelecity.org. The cost of this service is \$5.65 per month per recycling receptacle. The pick-up of the recycling receptacle is every other week on the same day as your waste service. The 2018 pickup calendar/schedule will be available on

### Keep Your Pipes Open To Avoid Freezing

Every year when the weather turns cold the City sees a rash of reports of frozen pipes. The best thing that you can do to prevent this in your home is to keep the pipes open. Leaving a slow drip or trickle in a faucet overnight, when the temperature and water usage is lowest, can prevent the water in your pipes from sitting still and freezing. As the weather gets colder over a longer stretch of time, the ground freezes

deeper and deeper and puts more homes at risk of frozen pipes every day. Yes, the slow drip or trickle may end up costing you a little extra on your water bill, but that amount will always be dramatically less than the cost to repair frozen pipes in your home and the water damage it can cause. ### 2018 Holiday Trash Pick up Schedule

Garbage will not be collected on the following Holidays in 2018:

New Year's Day (January 1, 2018) Memorial Day (May 28, 2018) Independence Day (July 4, 2018) Pioneer Day (July 24, 2018) Labor Day (September 3, 2018)

Veteran's Day (November 12, 2018)\* \*Observed Thanksgiving Day (November 22, 2018) Christmas Day (December 25, 2018)

During these weeks, service will be delayed one day starting with the holiday. If you have questions, please call Tooele City 435-843-2150 or Ace Disposal 435-882-7009.



Residents are encouraged to dispose of their Christmas trees by placing them at the curbside on their bulky waste pick-up day. In addition to Christmas trees, other acceptable items include: old appliances, furniture, carpet, couches and mattresses. All smaller items must be bagged, boxed or bundled. Bundles must be less than 5 ft. long, under 18" in diameter and less than 75 lbs., tied with twine.

**For Tooele City Residents:** If your trash container is broken or in need of repair, contact Tooele City at (435) 843-2150. If the damage is from normal wear and tear, the repairs or replacement will be made free of charge.

### Please Help Us Serve You Better By Doing The Following:

• Put your cans out by 6:30 a.m. • Place cans 3 feet apart • Do not overload cans

Do not place cans directly against the curb (when the cans are being set down, if they hit the curb it damages the wheels).
Promptly pull in your cans after they have been dumped—this helps our snowplow drivers to remove snow more efficiently from your street.
On windy days, please take care to ensure there is no loose garbage on the top that may blow out and litter the streets.

We appreciate your efforts to help us maintain a safe, clean and beautiful city!







City ordinance prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 2 a.m. to 6 a.m. from November 1st through March

31st. Please help city snowplow drivers by not parking on the streets and keeping things like basketball hoops off the streets! Thanks!

### ATTENTION BUSINESS OWNERS:

who Those have not paid their Commercial Business License Renewal Fee: A 50% LATE FEE will be implemented on February 1, 2018. You will have until March 1,2018 to pay the licensing fee + the penalty fee. You can mail in your payment, drop your payment off in the Finance Department at City Hall or in the drop box to the south of City Hall. If you are no longer in business, please let us know in writing by e-mailing lisac@tooelecity.org and we will be happy to close your license. ### BUSINESS LICENSES REQUIRED in Tooele City:

Anyone offering a SERVICE from their home, for compensation, requires a Tooele City Business License. Please call the Tooele City Recorder's Office (435) 843-2110 for more information.

ALL door-to-door salesmen (Itinerant/ Transient Merchants) must be licensed with Tooele City and must have a 2018 BLUE Tooele City ID Badge on and in plain sight. If a salesman is not wearing a badge, call the Recorder's Office at 435-843-2110 or Dispatch (after 5 p.m. & on weekends) at 435-882-5600. Please be sure to give a complete description of the individual and the direction they are headed. THANKS!



It is now Animal License Renewal time for 2018. Please renew your license by February 28<sup>th</sup> or your license fee will double as of March 1<sup>st.</sup>



The license renewal application must be accompanied by a current rabies vaccination certificate. 




