2018 was an amazing year! The year has gone by so quickly, but we have still been able to accomplish many things this year! The City Council and I held a Town Hall Meeting in February and prepared a survey to provide our residents the opportunity to express their feelings and make requests. Resident requests included increased numbers of police officers and improvements to our parks. We have hired additional police officers and also two community service officers. Plans for the greatly needed police station are nearly completed and we are scheduled to break ground in March of this year. New playground equipment has been installed at Linear Park. The concession stands at the Dow James and Red Del Pappa fields are nearly completed. Architectural drawings are nearly complete for a restroom facility at the Aquatic Center Park at 200 West and Vine, a new pavilion at the golf course, and a new irrigation system at Elton Park. Plans are being made to add additional parking and playing fields at England Acres, as well as improvements to other park facilities. Although the tax increase that was implemented this past year was difficult, it was needed to carry on the work of the City. The certified tax rate for Tooele City is still less than it was 20 years ago. We have been able to purchase much needed equipment with the additional funding. Some of the items include a new phone system that has replaced equipment that is over 20 years old, some flooring in City Hall, new police vehicles, snow removal equipment, and other much needed equipment.

Thank you for your support of our efforts to improve services to you. The Council and I will continue our transparent budget process again this year with another Town Hall Meeting to be scheduled in February.

Keep Your Pipes Open To Avoid Freezing

Every year when the weather turns cold the City sees a rash of reports of frozen pipes. The best thing that you can do to prevent this in your home is to keep the pipes open. Leaving a slow drip or trickle in a faucet overnight, when the temperature and water usage is lowest, can prevent the water in your pipes from sitting still and freezing. As the weather gets colder over a longer stretch of time, the ground freezes deeper and deeper and puts more homes at risk of frozen pipes every day. Yes, the slow drip or trickle may end up costing you a little extra on your water bill, but that amount will always be dramatically less than the cost to repair frozen pipes in your home and the water damage it can cause. Tooele City Residents: If your trash container is broken or in need of repair, contact Tooele City at (435) 843-2150. If the damage is from normal wear and tear, the repairs or replacement will be made free of charge.

Please Help Us Serve You Better By Doing The Following:

- Put your cans out by 6:30 a.m.
- Place cans 3 feet apart
- Do not overload cans
- Do not place cans directly against the curb (when the cans are being set down, if they hit the curb it damages the wheels).
- Promptly pull in your cans after they have been dumped—this helps our snowplow drivers to remove snow more efficiently from your street.
- On windy days, please take care to ensure there is no loose garbage that may blow away and litter the streets.

We appreciate your efforts to help us maintain a safe, clean, and beautiful city!



City ordinance prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 2 a.m. to 6 a.m. from November 1st through March 31st. Please help city snowplow drivers by not parking on the streets and keeping things like basketball hoops off the streets! Thanks!

ATTENTION BUSINESS OWNERS:

Those who have not paid their Commercial Business License Renewal Fee: A 50% LATE FEE will be implemented on February 1, 2019. You will have until March 1, 2019 to pay the licensing fee + the penalty fee. You can mail in your payment, drop your payment off in the Finance Department at City Hall or in the drop box to the south of City Hall. If you are no longer in business, please let us know in writing by e-mailing lisac@tooelecity.org and we will close your license. BUSINESS LICENSES REQUIRED in Tooele City:

Anyone offering a SERVICE from their home, for compensation, requires a Tooele City Business License. Please call the Tooele City Business Licensing Office at (435) 843-2110 for more information.

ALL door-to-door salesmen (Itinerant/Transient Merchants) must be licensed with Tooele City and must have a 2019 Bright ORANGE Tooele City ID Badge on and in plain sight. Animal Licenses

It is now Animal License Renewal time for 2019. Please renew your license by February 28th or your license fee will double as of March 1st.

All dogs and cats within Tooele City limits and over the age of four months must be licensed each year. The license renewal application must be accompanied by a current rabies vaccination certificate. License renewal fees may be paid at Tooele City Hall (90 North Main Street, Tooele) in the Finance Department. If you have any questions, please contact the Finance Department at (435) 843-2150.

Renewal Fees:

- Female/Male Dog - \$20.00
- Neutered or spayed dog - \$10.00
(Must indicate on Rabies Certificate animal is neutered or spayed or have supporting documentation.)
- Female/Male Cat - 10.00
- Spayed or Neutered Cat - \$5.00 (Must indicate on Rabies Certificate animal is neutered or spayed or have supporting documentation).
