## **Day Care/Preschool Guidelines Check List**

While the State of Utah licenses all day care facilities, the following requirements must be met in order to operate a day care/preschool in a RESIDENCE in Tooele City for **4 or more children (up to 8/16 children maximum)**. Please note that the following fees and requirements are subject to change.

\_\_\_\_\_1. Apply for a Business License: may be obtained from the Business License Specialist, 1<sup>st</sup> floor

2.	Apply for a Conditional Use Permit (required for more than 8, up to 16 children max), cost is \$150 (the application may be obtained from the Community Development Department OR the Tooele City Website > Home Occupation Conidtional Use Permit Application Packet <a href="https://tooelecity.org/city-departments/community-development/community-development-public-works-forms/">https://tooelecity.org/city-departments/community-development/community-development-public-works-forms/</a> ). Once the completed application is accepted by the Community Development Department, the Conditional Use Permit will be scheduled to be heard in a public hearing before the Planning Commission. The Planning Commission meets on the 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> Wednesdays of the month at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.
3.	To schedule an appointment for a Building Inspection = Call the Building Department/Community Development Department at (435) 843-2132.
4.	To schedule an appointment for a Fire Inspection = Our Fire Inspectors will contact you to schedule an inspection if one is needed.
5.	Obtain a Food Handlers Permit from the Tooele County Health Department = Call (435) 277-2440 (State of Utah Requirement) OR take online class to obtain permit at: <a href="http://www.tooelehealth.org/Environmental_Health/Food_Handlers_Class.html">http://www.tooelehealth.org/Environmental_Health/Food_Handlers_Class.html</a>
6.	If the day care/preschool passes all inspections and receives Planning Commission approval, the business license may then be approved and issued by the Business License Specialist.
7.	State childcare license is required ( <u>for 8 to 16 children</u> ) and can be obtained on their website at: <a href="http://health.utah.gov/licensing/ccf/public/cc_public.html">http://health.utah.gov/licensing/ccf/public/cc_public.html</a>

When ALL Departments have completed their inspections and given approval, the business license will then be issued once all fees are paid.
