You have the opportunity to apply for these voluntary benefits: (Click the links to watch a quick video!)

<u>Disability insurance</u> replaces a portion of income if a covered accident or sickness prevents you from earning a paycheck. This insurance can provide a monthly benefit to help cover any ongoing expenses, including necessities like food and housing.

<u>Accident insurance</u> helps offset unexpected covered medical expenses, such as emergency room fees, deductibles and co-payments that can result from a fracture, dislocation or other covered accidental injury.

<u>Hospital confinement indemnity insurance</u> provides lump-sum benefits for a covered hospital confinement or outpatient surgery to help with deductibles and other expenses that are not covered by most major medical plans.

<u>Cancer insurance</u> helps offset cancer diagnosis and treatment expenses that medical insurance doesn't cover. This coverage also provides a benefit for specified cancer-screening tests.

<u>Critical illness insurance</u> supplements your major medical coverage by providing a lump-sum benefit that you can use to pay the direct and indirect costs related to a covered critical illness, such as heart attack (myocardial infarction), end-stage renal (kidney) failure, stroke or major organ failure.

<u>Life insurance</u> enables you to tailor coverage for your individual needs and helps provide financial security for your family members. A helpful rule of thumb to determine the amount of life insurance you may need is to multiply your current salary by five to eight years.

- You can continue coverage with no increase inpremium when you retire or change jobs.
- You're paid regardless of any other insurance you may have with other insurance companies.
- Coverage is available for your spouse and dependent children.
