Notice is hereby given that Tooele City Corporation (OWNER) will accept bids for construction of the **Droubay Road Storm Drain Project - (Vine Street to Smelter Road)**, according to Drawings and Specifications prepared by Paul Hansen Associates, and described in general as:

*Work of this Construction Contract comprises the construction of approximately 3,800 linear feet of 15" and 24" diameter storm drain pipe, installation of storm water manholes, and related appurtenances.*

Separate sealed bids will be received by the OWNER in Room 227, of the Tooele City Municipal Offices located at 90 North Main, Tooele, Utah 84074 until 1:00 PM on Tuesday July 30, 2019, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

Bid security in the amount of 5% of the base bid will be required to accompany bids.

The object of the conference is to acquaint BIDDERS with the site conditions, specifications, and to answer any questions which BIDDERS may have concerning the project.
