CALL IF YOU CAN, TEXT IF YOU CAN'T

PHONE

- 1 Dial 911 on the phone
- 2 Remain calm, speak clearly
- 3 Know your location
- 4 Answer the questions
- 5 Don't hang up



TEXT

- 1 Open text messaging
- 2 In the "To" field enter 911
- 3 Push the "Send" button
- 4 Enter your location
- 5 Answer the questions

TEXTING TIPS:

- Text to 9-1-1 must be sent from a phone with a service plan
- Photos & video cannot be sent to 9-1-1 at this time
- Text to 9-1-1 will not work in a group message
- Please never text and drive

WHEN TO TEXT?

- When making a voice call could put you in danger
- If you are injured and cannot speak
- If you are in a remote location & can only send text messages
- If cell services is overwhelmed & only text messages get through
