Current Tooele City Code

**10-3-6. All Night Parking.**

No person shall park a vehicle on any public right-of-way between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. of any day from November 1 through March 31. This provision does not apply to authorized emergency vehicles in the performance of official duties.

Proposed Tooele City Code

**10-3-6. Snow Event Parking Restrictions - Removal of Vehicles - Penalty.**

(1) It shall be unlawful to park a vehicle on any public right-of-way:

(a) when snow is falling; or,

(b) when snow has accumulated in any amount on the right-of-way.

(2) Any vehicle parked in violation of this Section may be removed at the discretion of the Tooele City Police Department for creating public safety risks and for obstructing the City's snow removal efforts.

(3) The following are exempt from this Section:

(a) emergency vehicles and personnel in the performance of their functions and duties;  
and,

(b) Tooele City public works vehicles and employees in the performance of their functions and duties.

(4) A violation of this Section is punishable by a civil penalty of \$100.
