## WATER CONSERVATION SCHEDULE

**Area #1** All water users North of Vine and West of Main water Wednesdays and Saturdays.

**Area #2** All water users North of Vine and East of Main water Tuesdays and Fridays.

**Area #3** All water users South of Vine water Mondays and Thursdays.

**Outdoor watering is not permitted on Sundays.**

The City encourages residents not to water during the hottest hours of the day, typically between 10 am and 6 pm. This conserves water and reduces your water bills. If there are special circumstances that require a modified schedule for residents or businesses—such as newly planted sod or lawn, contact Tooele City at (435) 843-2150.

City parks and schools have been placed on a modified schedule because of the size of their lawn areas. While some parks and schools may be watering more than two days each week, a specific area of that park is only watered twice during the week.
