Residents are encouraged to dispose of their Christmas trees by placing them at the curbside on their bulky waste pick-up day. In addition to Christmas trees, other acceptable items include: old appliances, furniture, carpet, couches and mattresses. All smaller items must be bagged, boxed or bundled. Bundles must be less than 5 ft. long, under 18" in diameter and less than 75 lbs., tied with twine.

For Tooele City Residents: If your trash container is broken or in need of repair, contact Tooele City at (435) 843-2150. If the damage is from normal wear and tear, the repairs or replacement will be made free of charge.

Please Help Us Serve You Better By Doing The Following:

- Put your cans out by 6:30 a.m.
- Place cans 3 feet apart
- Do not overload cans
- Do not place cans directly against the curb (when the cans are being set down, if they hit the curb it damages the wheels).
- Promptly pull in your cans after they have been dumped—this helps our snowplow drivers to remove snow more efficiently from your street.
- On windy days, please take care to ensure there is no loose garbage on the top that may blow out and litter the streets.

ATTENTION BUSINESS OWNERS:

For those who have not paid their Business License Renewal fee: A 50% LATE FEE will be implemented on February 1, 2015. You will have until March 1, 2015 to pay the licensing fee + the penalty fee. If we have not heard from you, your license will be considered "inactive" and we will CLOSE your business after March 15, 2015. You can mail in your payment, drop your payment off in the Finance Department at City Hall OR in the drop box to the south of City Hall. If you are no longer in business, please let us know in writing, by e-mailing lisac@tooelecity.org and we will close your license. If you have questions, please contact the Recorder's Office at (435) 843-2110.

Anyone Offering a "service" from their home, for compensation, requires a Tooele City Business License. Call the Tooele City Recorder's Office (435) 843-2110 for more information. Also, ALL door-to-door salesmen (Itinerant/Transient Merchants) must be licensed with Tooele City and must have a **2015 Bright PINK Tooele City ID Badge** on and in plain sight. If salesmen aren't wearing a badge call (435) 843-2110 or Dispatch at (435) 882-5600 to report them.

Animal Licenses

It is now Animal License Renewal time for 2015. Please renew your license by February 28th or your license fee will double as of March 1st.

All dogs and cats within Tooele City limits and over the age of four months must be licensed each year. The license renewal application must be accompanied by a current rabies vaccination certificate. License renewal fees may be paid at Tooele City Hall (90 North Main Street, Tooele) in the Finance Department. If you have any questions, please contact the Finance Department at (435) 843-2150.

Renewal Fees:

Female/Male Dog - \$20.00

Neutered or spayed dog - \$10.00

(Must indicate on Rabies Certificate animal is neutered or spayed or have supporting documentation.)

Female/Male Cat - 10.00

Spayed or Neutered Cat - \$5.00 (Must indicate on Rabies Certificate animal is neutered or spayed or have supporting documentation).

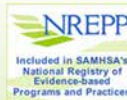

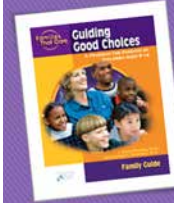

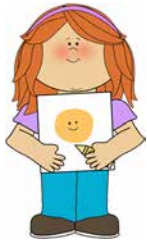
