We so desperately need water to fill our aquifers so that we can have plenty of water for the hot summer months that are ahead. I am also feeling grateful today for city employees who are out clearing snow from our roads, sidewalks and parking areas; for our police officers and firefighters who are responding emergencies and for those employees who are

supporting the efforts of others who are serving others today. Thank you to all of you for your dedication and hard work!

I want to update our residents on some projects that have been happening within the City. You may have noticed the large plastic sheeting covering the front of the Sons of Utah Pioneers Museum. ### Security Tips from the Tooele City Police Department



Due to ongoing vehicle burglary and vehicle theft trends, the Tooele City Police Department would like to remind you of some very important security tips:

Remember to keep your personal belongings and valuables out of view in your vehicles. It is also important to keep vehicle windows closed and doors locked. Often, stolen items are left in plain sight within the vehicle making them a prime target for thieves. There have been several reports of unlocked vehicles being targeted, rummaged through and items stolen. Some of the items have been used later to commit other crimes, such as Identity Theft and Fraud.

Commonly vehicles that are stolen have been left to idle in a driveway or garage. Remember, never leave your car running and unattended, even to warm it up in the morning. Never leave your keys in the car and always park in a well-lit area, when possible.

Finally, don't hesitate to report suspicious activity. If you see a suspicious person who appears to be looking in vehicles, or loitering in a neighborhood or parking lot for no legitimate reason, call dispatch at 435-882-5600.

## Winter Reminders

City ordinance prohibits parking on city streets between the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. from November to March.



Keep your driveway and walks clear so that firefighters, medics and postal workers can reach

your house or business.

When major storms occur, the fire hydrants nearest to our home should be kept clear so that firefighters can readily locate and use them.



All dogs and cats within Tooele City limits and over the age of four months must be licensed each year. The license renewal application must be accompanied by a current rabies vaccination certificate. License renewal fees may be paid at Tooele City Hall (90 North Main Street, Tooele) in the Finance Department. If you have any questions, please contact the Finance Department at (435) 843-2150.

#### Renewal Fees:

Female/Male Dog - \$20.00 Neutered or spayed dog - \$10.00

(Must indicate on Rabies Certificate animal is neutered or spayed or have supporting documentation.)

#### Female/Male Cat – 10.00 Spayed or Neutered Cat - \$5.00

(Must indicate on Rabies Certificate animal is neutered or spayed or have supporting documentation).
