MAYOR'S MESSAGE

MAYOR MARESA MANZIONE

As Tooele City continues to grow, we have to make sure our City organization grows with it. The FY2027 budget reflects that commitment by adding several positions that will help us continue providing the services our residents expect while preparing for the needs of a growing community. With the approval of the FY2027 budget, we will be adding an additional police officer, a code enforcement officer in the Community Development Department, a network specialist in our Information Technology Department, and an administrative assistant for the Fire Department.

We will also be beginning an incentive program for our volunteer fire department. Our volunteer firefighters give their time and talents to serve our community, often responding to emergencies while balancing jobs, families, and other responsibilities. We are grateful for their commitment, and this program is one way we can recognize their service and help strengthen our volunteer fire department for the future.

These additions are about more than simply adding positions. They are about making sure we have the people and resources necessary to keep up with the demands of a growing city and continue providing the level of service our residents deserve.

I am also excited to share some great news. The Tooele City Council and administration have been working with OKOA Capital LLC, the owner of the One O'Clock Hill Property, to reach an agreement that provides an opportunity for development while preserving One O'Clock Hill as open space.

Under the agreement, OKOA Capital LLC will be able to use its water rights for development within Tooele City, with a portion of those water rights specifically limited to an infill area. In exchange, Tooele City will receive the donation of the One O'Clock Hill property, which will remain open space.

I believe this is an excellent outcome for our community. One O'Clock Hill is a recognizable part of our community, and preserving the property as open space will ensure that it remains that way for future generations. At the same time, directing a portion of the water rights toward an infill area supports the kind of development we should be encouraging—development that makes better use of areas already within our community rather than continually expanding outward.

This agreement provides an opportunity to support responsible development while preserving an important part of Tooele's character. I appreciate OKOA Capital LLC for working with the City Council and administration to reach this agreement.
