



The Life's Worth Living Foundation is excited to present "Proud" a \$250,000, 18' bronze veteran sculpture by Dan Snarr in the Tooele City Veterans Memorial Park (corner of Main & Vine). This will be the 1st of its kind sculpture in the U.S. to address Veteran Suicide. It will provide local Veteran resources, and raise awareness to this growing problem. SOURCE PROTECTION ACT FOR CLEAN WATER

The Drinking Water Source Protection Plan for Tooele City is available for your review. It contains information about source protection zones, potential contamination sources, and management strategies to protect each of our drinking water sources. Potential contamination sources common in our protection areas include sanitary sewer lines, septic tanks, roads, residential, commercial and industrial areas, etc. These sources of potential contamination are typically classified as a low susceptibility. Sources which are classified as medium susceptibility include buried fuel storage tanks, accidental spills of potential contaminants, or other similar conditions. The City has developed management strategies to further protect all of our sources from contamination. Please contact the Public Works Department at (435) 843-2130, if you have questions or


