COMMERCIAL CONSTRUCTION

In order to speed up the plan review process, it is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that all plan review information is completed at the time of submittal.

Water rights, reimbursment fees, and impact fees are required in accordance with Tooele City Code prior to issuance of the building pemit

This is a **partial list** of the most common items not provided with a building permit application. Contact the Building Department at 435-843-2132 with any questions.

NOTE: A separate submittal is required for civil & site plan (see site plan review checklist provided by City Engineer).

Building Permit submittals should include the following:

- Site plan showing location of all buildings and structures.
- Geological site report.
- Structural Calculation packet listing design criteria.
- Construction Specifications.
- Special Inpsction Quality Assurance Program ref. CH 17 IBC.
- Name of special inspection firm with inspectors names and a copy of their certifications.
- 2021 IECC certificats of compliance for mechanical, lighting, and building envelope.
- Complete code analysis for building justification (Construction Type, Sprinkled, Occupant Load Exiting, etc.)
- Complete **WET STAMPED & SIGNED** Construction Plans.
- Construction plans shold include:
 - Cover sheet showing design criteria.
 - o Floor Plans.
 - Building sections and elevations
 - Completee Architectureal, Structural, Electrical, Mechanical, and Plumbing plans. Including isometric and claculations for water lines and gas line sizing (Tooele natural gas 867 BTU/cubic ft.)
 - Basic Design Wind Speed 105 mph, seismic category D
 - o Complete wet stampled design for suspended ceilings.

Additional materials needed include:

- Fire sprinkler and Alarm plans (Deferred submittal allowed).
- Utah State Department of Transportation Access Permit for any accesses onto State Highways.
- Utah State Storm Water Permit for site disturbances sites of one or more acres.

- Tooele County health Department Plan Review Approval Letter for food related occupancies, Swimming Pools, and Spas.
- Complete Building Permit Application with deposit.

NOTE: Tooele city ordinance 3-3-14 and 3-3-15 require smoke and heat vent skylights and internal coaxial antenna systems. Submitted plans to address these features. Contact the Tooele City Fire Marshall: Nick Wall nickw@tooelecity.gov
