

Strategic Investment

BLUF: Strategic investment in water and infrastructure is essential to unlock the TEAD south development potential.

- The current Utah National Guard Armory is outdated and requires replacement to support longterm mission readiness.
- The site lacks sufficient water infrastructure, preventing new development and economic expansion.


