RESOLUTION 2026-61

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOOELE CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING THE FINAL TAX RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027.

WHEREAS, Utah Code §10-6-133 requires cities to set by ordinance or resolution the real and personal property tax levy, or tax rate, for various municipal purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the certified tax rate has been calculated by the Utah State Tax Commission to be .002527 for Fiscal Year 2026-2027; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council proposes to not adopt the Tax Commission certified tax rate but to adopt the proposed tax rate of .002590 for Fiscal Year 2026-2027; and,

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2026, the City Council adopted a tentative budget proposing a tax rate of .002590 for Fiscal Year 2026-2027, which exceeds the Certified Tax Rate, triggering the requirement for a Truth in Taxation public hearing pursuant to Utah Code §59-2-919; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed tax rate increase will generate an additional \$238,092 in property tax revenue, \$138,092 of which shall be applied towards the Judgement Levy Bond payment increase and \$100,000 of which shall be used by the Tooele City Fire Department to fund volunteer stipends and to employ an administrative assistant; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council convened in a truth-in-taxation public hearing on the proposed tax rate on August 19, 2026, together with the public hearing on the final budget:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOOELE CITY COUNCIL that the Tooele City real and personal property tax levy, or tax rate, is hereby set at **0.002590** for Fiscal Year 2026-2027.

This Resolution shall become effective on the date of passage by authority of the Tooele City Charter.
